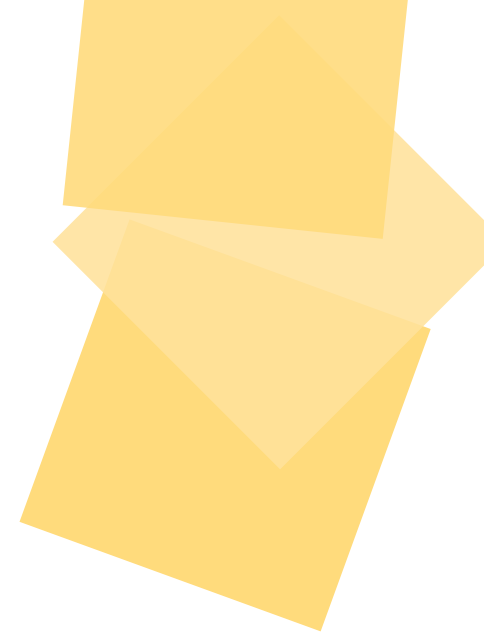
We actively contribute our expertise to the playground standards committee – and since our founding, also to the Subcommittee on Inclusion.

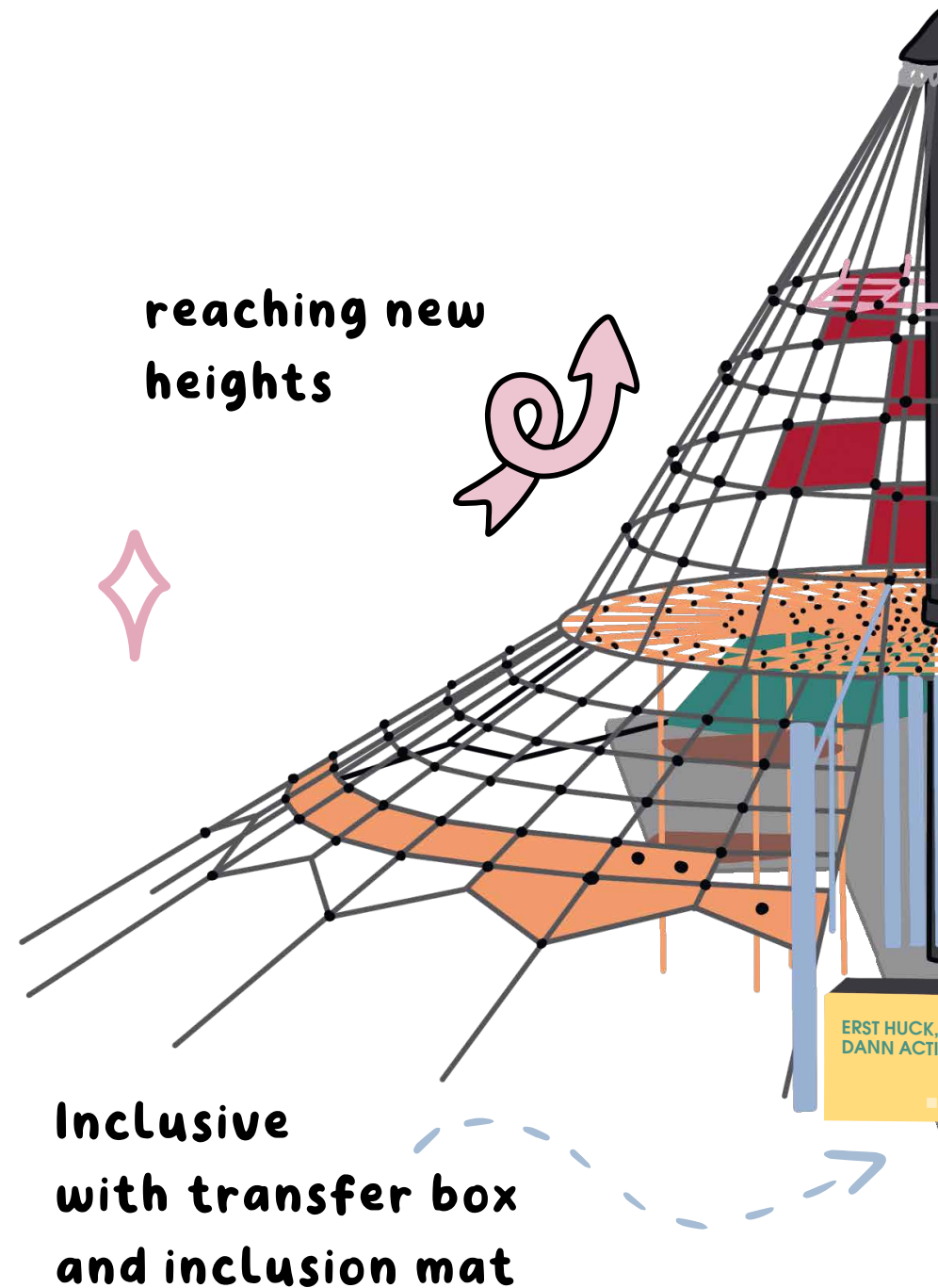

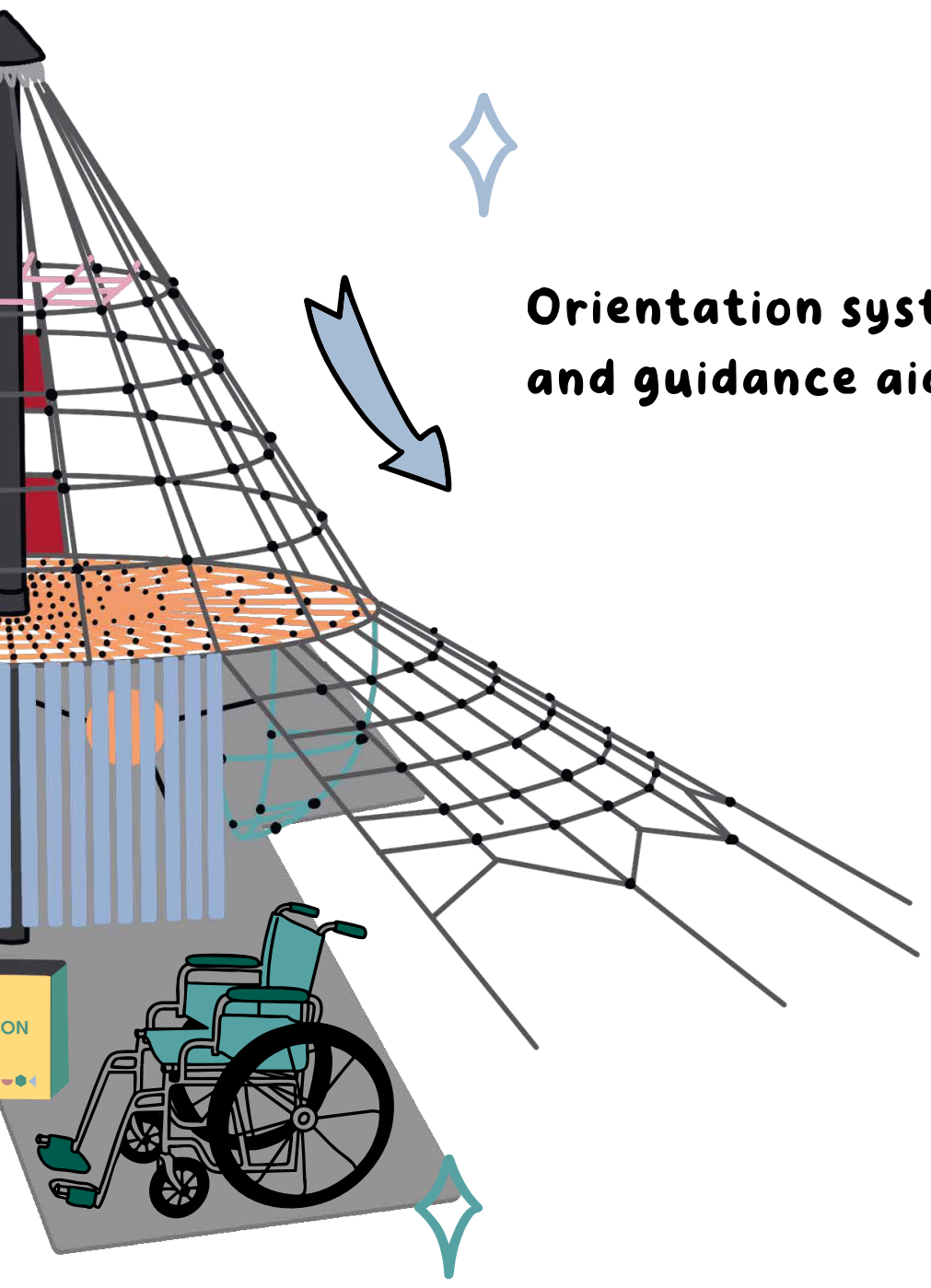

At its core lies the idea that no single product is inclusive by itself – instead, existing concepts can be made more inclusive step by step.

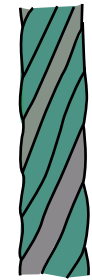




## Orientation systems and guidance aids

black

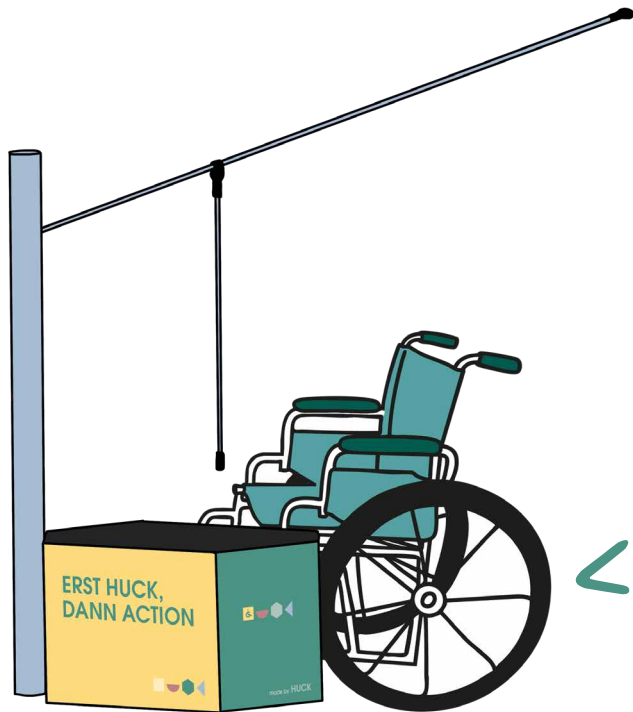


**Hard:**

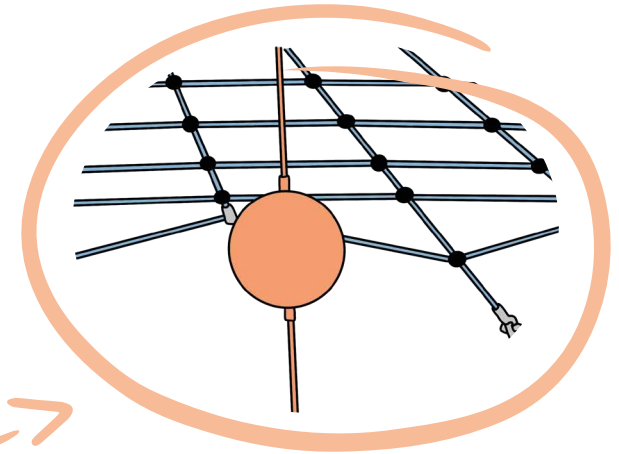
## Flexible modules

Modules can be adapted to the project's needs – for maximum planning freedom.



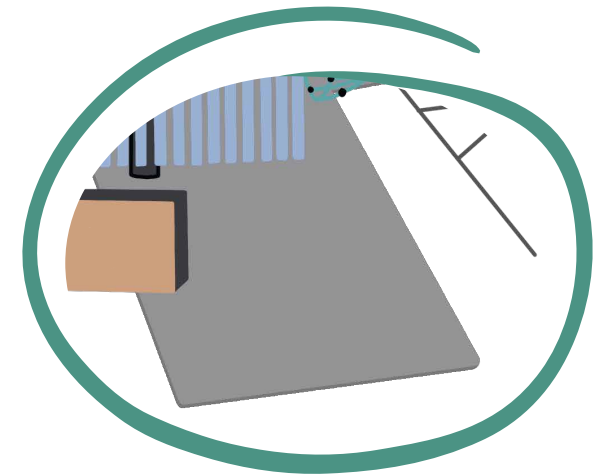
## Fender balance

Enables transfer from wheelchair to play equipment – for genuine participation.



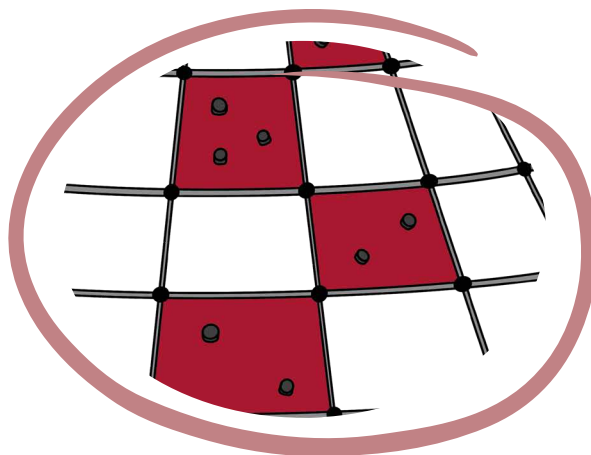
## Inclusion mat

Can be combined with any safety surface.



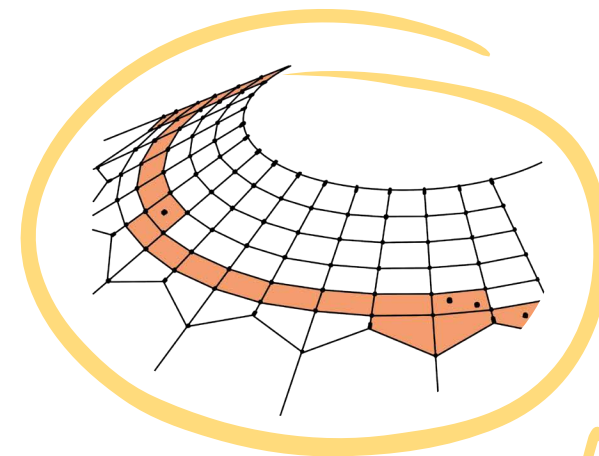
## Rubber mat path difficult

This particularly challenges sure-footedness and body control – an exciting balancing act for all age groups.



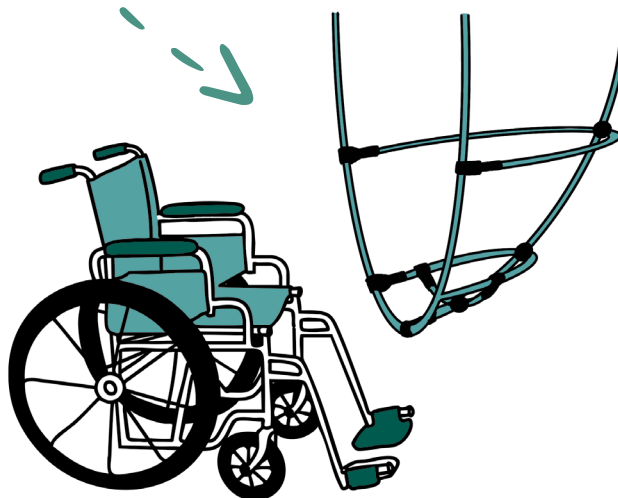
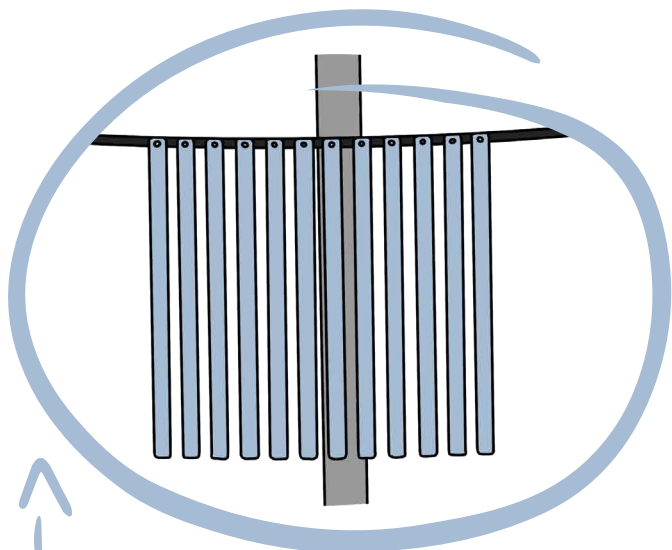
## Rope swing

Trains balance and coordination and offers a sensory experience for feet and body.

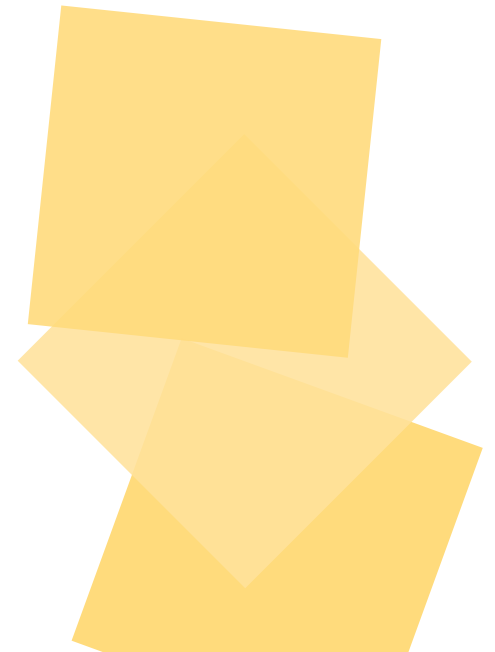
